Sniper Pro Shop/High Ground Training Group will provide the SPS/HGTG Law Enforcement Firearms Instructor course 14 – 18 October 2023 at the Martin Police Department in Martin, TN. A limited number of positions will be available for the course and will be provided to Law Enforcement Agencies on a first come, first served basis. Advance course registration is required with cutoff for registration 45 days prior to the course. All information is required for application to be considered. Course positions will not be held without registration and payment arrangements.

Course tuition will be invoiced after 1 July 2024. An online payment portal will be active after 1 July 2024 for agencies wishing to pay by credit card.

Course Description

This is a 5-day, 40-hour course of instruction to develop instructional skills for the professional law enforcement firearms instructor. The course will include:

- Instructional skills development;
- Presentation Techniques;
- Safety Protocols;
- Understanding the Roles of Biomechanics and Ergonomics in Shooting;
- New Shooter Training Techniques;
- In Service Training Techniques;
- Coaching Shooters;
- Course of Fire Development;
- And more.

Participants will be required to safely present courses of fire, successfully complete a written exam, demonstrate ability to manage a live-fire training event and score a minimum of 90% on a graded course of fire.

Prerequisites: Full-Time Law Enforcement Officer assigned as a firearms instructor by his/her agency. Must be an above average shooter and will be required to fire a minimum of 90% score on a qualification course of fire with the duty handgun.

Materials Needed:

- 1. Duty Handgun with 3 magazines and Duty Belt;
- 2. Off-Duty Weapon with concealment belt holster or concealment holster for duty weapon;
- 3. Backup Gun with one extra magazine (may be the same as the off-duty but YOU WILL NEED AN ANKLE HOLSTER;
- 4. Revolver (recommend 2" .38 Special off-duty/back-up type weapon) This may be the same weapon used for the backup gun and off-duty drills;
- 5. Duty Shotgun;
- 6. Body Armor;
- 7. Ball cap or other appropriate headgear;
- 8. Eve protection;
- 9. Amplified Ear Protection This is required for improved communications in the instructional setting;
- 10. 600 Rounds Handgun Training Ammunition;
- 11. 100 Rounds Off-Duty/Backup Handgun Ammunition;
- 12. 100 Rounds Field Loads (game load) for Shotgun;
- 13. 100 Rounds Revolver Ammunition:
- 14. 25 Rounds Duty Buck Shot;
- 15. 25 Rounds Duty Slug;
- 16. Appropriate Weapon Maintenance Gear;
- 17. Appropriate Cold and Wet Weather Gear.

Handgun Optics

We will include an optional Handgun Optics Training (HOT) clinic in this course for instructor candidates who have optics or are in the process of adopting optics for their agencies. Officers participating in the HOT clinic should bring an additional 200 rounds of handgun ammunition.

COURSE ENROLLMENT REQUIREMENTS

LAW ENFORCMENT PERSONNEL

- ① Participant must be a full-time, certified law enforcement or corrections officer.
- Participant must provide a signed affidavit of assignment and approval to attend and pending relative assignment. Blank affidavit is included in this packet.

MILITARY PERSONNEL

- Participant must be current active-duty service member either full-time, Reserve or National Guard.
- Participant must provide signed affidavit of assignment and approval to attend and pending relative assignment. Blank affidavit is included in this packet.

REGISTRATION AND PAYMENT

- All applications for enrollment must be submitted by 60 days prior to the start of the course of training.
- Payment must be made to Sniper Pro Shop by 30 days prior to the course.

CANCELLATION POLICY

- ⊕ Cancellations after 30 days prior to the course will be refunded 50% of the course tuition.
- ⊕ Cancellations after 2 weeks prior to the course will result in forfeiture of paid tuition.
