High Ground Training Group will provide a Law Enforcement Rangemaster course 26 - 30 August 2024 at the Cookeville Police Department in Cookeville, TN. A limited number of positions will be available for the course and will be provided to Law Enforcement Agencies on a first come, first served basis. Advance course registration is required with cutoff for registration 45 days prior to the course. All information is required for application to be considered. Course positions will not be held without registration and payment arrangements. Prerequisites apply for this course.

Payment must be made to Sniper Pro Shop no later than 30 days prior to the course.

COURSE DESCRIPTION

LAW ENFORCEMENT RANGEMASTER

Many Rangemaster courses tend to only be continuing education firearms instructor and/or shooting courses neglecting many of the skills necessary to manage a contemporary law enforcement firearms training program. The SPS/HGTG Law Enforcement Rangemaster Course is drawn from the experience of over 30 years in firearms instruction and program management. LERM will prepare the Firearms Instructor to manage both a firearms training facility and an agency training program. This course will include:

- program management
- statistics tracking for success
- range development
- range management
- environmental concerns
- developing training budgets
- advanced live-fire training

Participants will develop a plan for management of their range facility during the course.

COURSE ENROLLMENT REQUIREMENTS

The LERM course is Part 3 of the SPS/HGTG LE Firearms Instructor and Rangemaster Trilogy program. Instructors who have successfully completed the SPS LEFI course will receive SPS/HGTG Certification as a Phase III LE Firearms Instructor/Rangemaster.

You may attend this course if you are an LE Firearms Instructor and have attended a recognized LE Firearms Instructor course regardless of your original Firearms Instructor course provider.

This course prepares the senior LEFI to work as a Rangemaster where he/she will

- Manage a range facility
- Manage range assets
- Oversee an agency firearms training program
- Provide insight and direction in range design and updates

Course Prerequisites

- ① Participant must be a full-time, certified law enforcement or corrections officer.
- ⊕ Participant assigned or pending assignment as a Firearm Instructor.
- ⊕ Participant must have completed a recognized LE Firearms Instructor course.
- ① Our LEFI course is not a prerequisite for this course.
- Participant must provide a signed affidavit of assignment and approval to attend and pending relative assignment.
- ⊕ Blank affidavit is included in this packet.

MILITARY PERSONNEL

- ⊕ Participant must be current active-duty service member either full-time, Reserve or National Guard.
- Participant must provide signed affidavit of assignment and approval to attend and pending relative assignment. Blank affidavit is included in this packet.

Student contact information is required. Course instructors must be able to communicate directly with students prior to the course.

Each trainee will need the following:

- ⊕ Laptop Computer with up-to-date Microsoft Office Word and PowerPoint
- ⊕ Note-taking Material
- ⊕ Handgun
- ⊕ Holster
- ⊕ 3 Magazines
- ⊕ Duty Belt or Concealment Holster with magazine pouches

The Rangemaster candidate will be required to complete two projects for successful completion of the course.

- 1. Given a theoretical geographic location, design a law enforcement range training facility.
 - a. Using provided programs, design a range layout.
 - b. Write a 200–500-word description of the designed range facility detailing range operation and training plans.
- Design an original graded Tactical Handgun Qualification course and demonstrate proficiency in the course by presenting it on the range with members of the class completing the course of fire.

Course Cadre

Denny Elliott's law enforcement career spanned over 29 years. During that time, he served in a variety of agencies and assignments in Tennessee, Kentucky and as a member of a federal agency. This service includes:

He holds instructor certifications in firearms, baton, defensive tactics, edged weapons, law enforcement ethics and Below 100 among others. He has been a presenter for state and national level conferences for the Tennessee Law Enforcement Training Officers Association, American Society for Law Enforcement Trainers and International Association of Law Enforcement Firearms Instructors.

He retired from full-time law enforcement in 2018 and continues his training career as the CEO and Master Instructor of Sniper Pro Shop and High Ground Training Group, a U.S. Government Services Administration (GSA) approved vendor for homeland security and combat skills training for federal agencies and U.S. Military. SPS/HGTG has provided training for LE and Military personnel since 2008.
