Course registration deadlines are 45 days prior to the start date of the course.

Sniper Pro Shop / High Ground Training Group will provide the Level II Advanced Sniper Course in Tennessee in 2024. A limited number of positions will be available for this course and will be provided to Law Enforcement Agencies or military units on a first come, first served basis. Advance course registration is required with cutoff for registration 45 days prior to the course. All information is required for application to be considered. Course positions will not be held without registration and payment arrangements.



COURSE DESCRIPTION

LEVEL II SNIPER

Level II Sniper is an advanced sniper course that builds upon the skills taught in Level I Sniper. The sniper will study operational concepts based upon historical operational data and will build skills accordingly. Level II Sniper takes the sniper outside his traditional comfort zone and works toward building skills in non-traditional shooting positions, urban hide building and advanced skills. Participant must have completed a recognized Basic Sniper Course.

Completed registration must be received by 45 days prior to the course. Payment must be made to Sniper Pro Shop no later than 30 days prior to the course. Application page and appropriate affidavit page should be completed and sent to Sniper Pro Shop:

Sniper Course Physical Fitness Standards for Level I and II Sniper Courses

Participants should have a suitable level of physical fitness to perform the necessary functions of a police sniper. Participants enrolling in any of the sniper courses should be able to:

- Run 440 yards in 2.5 minutes or less while wearing field uniform and boots:
- Climb stairs and ladders while carrying standard sniper weapons and kit;
- Move rapidly from one shooting location to another and quickly assume necessary shooting positions;
- Be able to maintain shooting positions for extended time periods;
- Be able to negotiate multiple types of terrain crawling, walking and running while carrying sniper weapon system and kit.
- Failure to be able to complete any of the above may result in the failure to complete the course.





COURSE ENROLLMENT REQUIREMENTS

LAW ENFORCMENT PERSONNEL

- Participant must be a full-time, certified law enforcement or corrections officer.
- Participant assigned or pending assignment as a SWAT Sniper, Marksman, Scout, etc. by his agency will be given preference for placement in the course.
- Participant must have completed a Level I or recognized Basic Sniper course prior to attending this class and must provide a copy of their certificate for that course.
- Participant must provide a signed affidavit of assignment and approval to attend and pending relative assignment. Blank affidavit is included in this packet.

MILITARY PERSONNEL

- Participant must be current active-duty service member either full-time, Reserve or National Guard.
- Participant must have completed a military sniper course of instruction prior to attending this course.
- Participant must provide signed affidavit of assignment and approval to attend and pending relative assignment. Blank affidavit is included in this packet.

Course positions will not be held with completed registrations.

Student contact information is required. Course instructors must be able to communicate directly with students prior to the course.

<u>Cancellation Policy: Cancellations after 30 days prior to the course will be refunded 50% of the course tuition.</u> Cancellations after 2 weeks prior to the course will result in forfeiture of paid <u>tuition.</u>

SNIPER WEAPON SYSTEMS

Agency should provide a serviceable Sniper Weapon System equipped with contemporary tactical optic - mounted with quality tactical mounting system, bipod, and sling. Weapon system should be setup appropriately and ready for live-fire. SPS/HGTG staff will inspect the weapon prior to training. Minor adjustments may be made by SPS/HGTG staff. Triggers pull weights requiring adjustment, will require written permission from agency SWAT command level personnel during the class. SPS will have at least one "school gun" on site for the class, but does not guarantee that replacement weapons will be available to students who bring unserviceable equipment to the course. Weapons requiring extensive maintenance or service will be deadlined to ensure the quality of training for the overall class.

TRIGGER WEIGHT REQUIREMENTS

All trainee weapons will be inspected by HGTG Armorers prior to live fire and any weapon having a trigger weight under 3.0 pounds will be deemed unsafe and sidelined with no exceptions. The trainee will be unable to continue the course of instruction with any rifle that the Training Staff deems to be unsafe. It is incumbent upon the trainee and his/her agency to ensure that the weapon system is safe for training and deployment. Any trainee weapon system that is deemed to be unsafe will result in the trainee being released from the course. No refund will be given to the agency for a release of a student due to a safety issue. Military weapons will be required to meet unit specifications.

MUZZLE DEVICES

RIFLES EQUIPPED WITH MUZZLE BRAKES/COMPENSATORS WILL BE RESTRICTED FROM ALL SPS/HGTG COURSES. RIFLES EQUIPPED WITH COMPENSATORS MUST HAVE EITHER A SUPPRESSOR OR BLAST SHIELD DIVERTER THAT REDIRECTS VENTED GASSES DOWN RANGE. THERE WILL BE NO EXCEPTION TO THIS POLICY.

Each trainee will need the following:

- Match Grade Sniper Rifle equipped with Optical Sight, Bipod and Sling in .308 Winchester, 6.5 Creedmoor or .223
 Remington (5.56) (any other caliber must be approved prior to reporting for training)
- ⊕ Quality Optical Sight (Recommend variable sight with tactical reticle MRAD or MOA)
- ⊕ 500 rounds of Match Grade/Duty ammunition
- Spotting Scope with Tripod and Binoculars
- ⊕ Tripod Rifle Rest
- ⊕ Logbook
- Uniform (recommend camouflage BDUs)
- Headgear (recommend "boonie" style hat)
- ⊕ Hydration system
- ⊕ Load bearing equipment as issued by department with duty belt and sidearm
- ① Appropriate Hot, Cold and Wet Weather gear for the season and region of training event
- ⊕ Eye and Ear Protection
- ⊕ Calculator
- Pen and Pencil
- ⊕ Pocket Notebook
- Weapon Cleaning Gear
- ① Insect repellant and sunscreen as appropriate for the season and region of the training event
- ⊕ Knife Fixed blade or folding tactical
- ⊕ Multi-plier tool
- Pruning shear or other tool suitable to cut or remove small vegetation
- Appropriate Camo Gear Ghillie Suit, Sniper veil or other camouflage gear for rural stalking
- Ground cloth or shooting mat
